Dear Parishioners,

With the octave of Easter now complete, we can look back at our celebration of Holy Week and Easter, and, I pray, realize what a beautiful experience it was as once again we proclaimed Jesus risen from the dead. The knowledge of this triumph of God in the resurrection should give us hope: one day, we can all be united in God's Kingdom if we have led a life filled with faith.

Concerning our Capital Campaign, we are doing so well, over \$570,000.00 as of Tuesday morning. Some have asked when ground breaking will begin. We are required to have half the money in cash for a specific project before we can break ground. This would obviously have to be in addition to the bills we have to pay upfront for the campaign and the architect and the money we have to set aside for our parish contribution to the Catholic Charity Fund Appeal. It is my best guess, that we would need approximately a quarter of a million dollars in cash before ground breaking begins. Already, we have almost \$100,000.00 in cash from the pledges, so we are well on our way. My thanks again for your tremendous generosity.
