HOLY WEEK

Holy week is the most solemn week of the Church's year. Our participation in this Sacred Triduum draws us all into the sacred mysteries of our salvation. The celebration and service of Holy Week are listed below:

CHRISM MASS: Each year the Bishop blesses all the oils that are used in the sacraments at this special Mass at which all the priests renew their vows. This will take place Monday, April 10th at the Cathedral of St. Peter and Paul in Providence at 7PM.

FAST AND ABSTINENCE: Good Friday is a day when we fast, only one main meal is taken and abstain from meat.

DAILY MASS: Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday at 7:00AM and 12:10PM.

HOLY THURSDAY: The solemn Mass of the Last Supper, the celebration of the MANDATUM, Eucharistic procession. 7:00PM. Eucharistic adoration until midnight.

GOOD FRIDAY: Stations of the Cross 3:00PM, Solemn Service of the Lord's Passion 7:00PM.

HOLY SATURDAY: Easter Vigil: 7:00PM.

CONFESSIONS: Holy Saturday, 4:00-4:45PM

EASTER SUNDAY: Masses 7:30, 9:00, 10:30.
