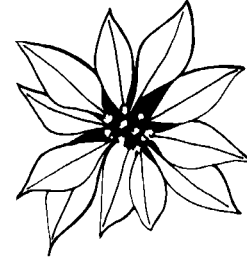


## MARCH FOR LIFE TRIP
