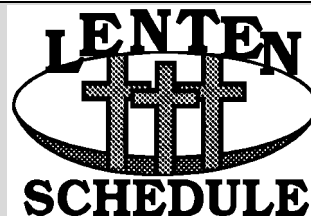

Lent begins this Wednesday as we are signed with blest ashes to signify our entrance into this penitential season. Each year the Church gives us this sacred season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving to help us prepare well for Easter. Masses for ASH WEDNESDAY are at 7AM, 9:30AM, 12:10PM and 7PM. Here at Mount Carmel there are a variety of ways for us to partake in this season:

DAILY MASS during the season of Lent will be at 7AM and 12:10PM, Saturday morning at 9:00AM

LENTEN MISSION will take place Monday through Wednesday, March 8th, 9th and 10th at 7:00PM. Fr. David Engo will be our speaker.

RICE BOWLS are a way to assist with our almsgiving during Lent. Place your spare change/bills in the bowl each day. These monies will be collected as the second collection on PALM SUNDAY to assist Catholic Relief Services in the great work that agency does throughout the world.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION takes place on the Fridays of Lent beginning after the 12:10 Mass and concluding with Stations of the Cross and Benediction at 7:00PM.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS each Friday evening at 7:00PM.

CONFESSIONS are heard every Saturday from 4:00PM to 4:45PM. Likewise, on Monday, March 1st from 6:00PM to 8:00PM, confessions will be available.

FAST AND ABSTINENCE: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are to be days of FAST (only one main meal should be taken) and ABSTINENCE (no meat should be eaten). **LIKewise**, all the **FRIDAYS** of Lent are days of **ABSTINENCE**.
