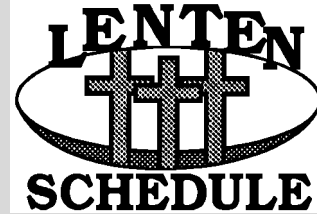
OLMC PARISHIONERS**"WE NEED YOUR RECIPES"**
