## NEW PEWS

The process for this project of our Capital Campaign is well under way. After a five year process of prioritizing all our various needs, review and consultation, and a capital campaign, the Egan Company and New Holland Pews were selected by our finance council, for this one of the last projects of our endeavor. A type of pew was selected of Solid Oak which was on display in the back of the Church. The finish of the pew was selected to match the wood in the Sanctuary and fabric for the kneelers was selected to contrast well with the ceramic tile in the Church. The addition of new pews to the Church represents only 8% of the total money raised for our Capital Campaign. Next week in the bulletin, we will be offering for purchase our current pews, both the large (\$300.00) and small (\$200.00). They would make a splendid addition to your homes especially if you have them refinished. They are an important memorabilia of our Church. The remaining pews that aren't sold will be donated to the Franciscan Friars Minor of South Bend Indiana, for their oratory that currently has no pews. The Friars will send a truck to pick them up. On Sunday, July 25<sup>th</sup> after the 10:30AM Mass we need as many as possible able bodied volunteers to assist in dismantling and taking out current pews. Other parishes have done this and there is a great savings involved. WILL YOU HELP US??? Next week in the Bulletin we will have a form to fill out to volunteer for this task. The more people the better! Once the pews are out, only 12 days would be needed to refinish the hardwood floors and install the new pews. Therefore, only one weekend of Masses in the parish hall would be required. This is an exciting time for our parish, and I hope that as many people as possible can help with removing our current the pews, and purchasing these same pews for their families and their homes.
