## LENT 2007

Here at Mount Carmel there are many ways for us to participate in this penitential season:

**DAILY MASS:** during the Season of Lent there will be daily Mass M-F at 7:00AM and 12:10PM, Sat at 9:00AM.

**RICE BOWLS:** The Rice Bowls are a vehicle for us to help feed the hungry of the world. Through the auspices of Catholic Relief Services, the monies collected through these bowls go directly to those in need. Place these bowls in a prominent place in your homes. The money placed in them will be collected on Palm Sunday at the Second Collection.

**EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION:** takes place on the Fridays of Lent beginning at 1:00PM and concluding with the Stations of the Cross at 7:00PM.

**THE STATIONS OF THE CROSS,** are every Friday evening at 7:00PM concluding with Solemn Benediction.

**FAST AND ABSTINENCE:** Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of FAST (only one main meal should be taken) and ABSTINENCE (no meat should be eaten. All the Fridays of Lent are days of ABSTINENCE.

**CONFESSION** is every Saturday from 4-4:45PM. Extra confession times: **THIS MONDAY, MARCH 19th, 6-8PM** (Eight Priests will be available.)
