Volunteers needed: Any person over the age of eighteen (18) interested in volunteering as a Catechist should call the office at 253-5052 for more information.

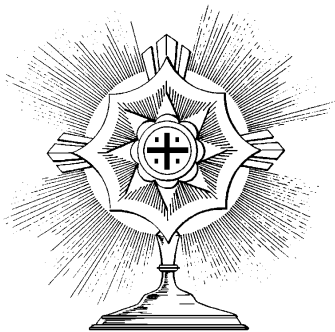
