Lent has is almost half over! Each year the church gives us this sacred season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving so as to prepare well for Easter. Here at Mount Carmel there are a variety of ways for us to partake in this penitential season:

DAILY MASS during the season of Lent will be at 7:00AM **AND** 12:10PM.

RICE BOWLS are a way to assist with our almsgiving during Lent. Place your spare change/bills in the bowl each day. These monies will be collected as the second collection on Palm Sunday to assist Catholic Relief Services in the great work that agency does throughout the world.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION takes place on the Friday's of Lent beginning after the 12:10PM Mass and concluding with Stations of the Cross and Solemn Benediction at 7:00PM

STATIONS OF THE CROSS every Friday evening at 7:00PM

FAST & ABSTINENCE Ash Wednesday & Good Friday were days of FAST (only one main meal should be taken and ABSTINENCE (no meat should be eaten.) LIKEWISE, all FRIDAYS of Lent are days of ABSTINENCE
